People are not to be standing in the middle of the main arena – this raises safety issues and concerns – this area is for judges, competitors and their horses. People can stand instead, on the outside track near the fence. Lyn suggested a special coloured vest be worn by a workplace and safety person who goes around keeping people at a safe distance from the centre of the main arena. Mars suggested information be sent again, out by email, about riding to times and being prepared to ride early. **There will be no riding in the main arena and indoor once the competition has finished due to Workplace, Health and Safety.**
